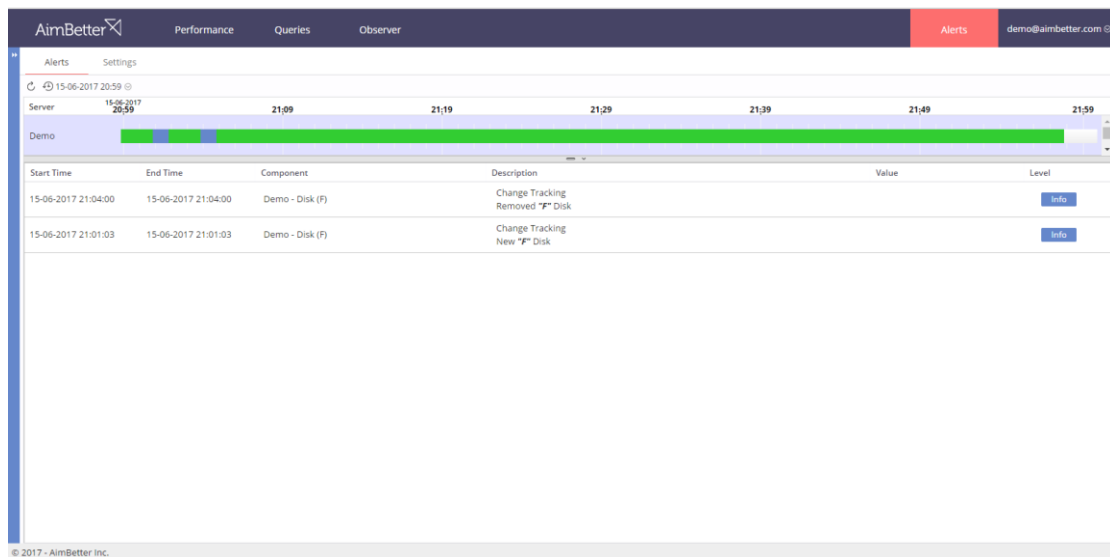

## ■ Change tracking module

The change tracking module is now alerting, on mail and alert tab, not only on changes but also on new and removed of the following components:

- 1) Databases
- 2) Disk
- 3) Network cards
- 4) Services
- 5) Software's


Alerts tab example: (Disk new and removed)


You can change every component to specific track, see previous screen shot, then you will have to enter the exact name of the component.


We added the ability to edit you email settings


