#### Change tracking module

The change tracking module is now alerting, on mail and alert tab, not only on changes but also on new and removed of the following components:

- 1) Databases
- 2) Disk
- 3) Network cards
- 4) Services
- 5) Software's

You can change every component to specific track, see previous screen shot, then you will have to enter the exact name of the component.

Please notice choosing specific will check only what you entered. The rule is working like other tools when you set it on the account level it will work on all you servers unless there is a setting on a lower level, server level for example.

Setting the schedule means that you will receive alerts only during the settings.

- 1) You can deactivate days.
